

Archdiocese distributes grants

The Archdiocese of Dubuque and Catholic Charities have announced funding being contributed to 44 parish-based projects, including food banks, service trips and outreach programs through Harvest of Blessings program.

A total of \$35,846 was raised through private donations. That money will be split into \$500 grants and distributed to local parishes for use in specific programs.

The newly refocused Harvest of Blessings program allows parishes to make local decisions about how to support those in need, as well as the broader community they serve.

In Dubuque, the Church of the Nativity, Cathedral of St. Raphael and St. Patrick Parish will use the money to show the short film "Ghost People: Seeing All the People in our Community," and St. Anthony Parish will put it toward the Kids Against Hunger program.
