On February 26, the U.S. Supreme Court denied the Administration's request for expedited review of the decision partially blocking the termination of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, or DACA. That decision by the Supreme Court in Department of Homeland Security v. Regents of the University of California sends the case back to the Ninth Circuit to follow the traditional appeals process, which is expected to take months. *This means that for now DACA renewals remain available to those who currently have DACA status*.
