- [Amnesty International Americas](#) campaigns for a world where human rights are enjoyed by all and are currently monitoring the situation in Mexico.
- [UNICEF](#) is working with the Mexican government to provide safe drinking water, hygiene, and sanitation packs as well as assessing psychosocial support and training on nutrition and child protection.
- [Catholic Charities USA](#) advocates for just and compassionate migration and refugee policies that respect the life and dignity of each person.
- The [Florence Project](#), the only organization in Arizona serving detained immigrant men, women, and children as well as asylum seekers, is seeking to increase staffing in anticipation of the increased need once the government begins detaining the refugees.
- [The Kino Border Initiative](#) is a humanitarian assistance, education, and advocacy organization that provides shelter and food to asylum seekers. Its partnership with the Florence Project means those it serves also receive Know Your Rights training as well as some legal representation. Both are recruiting volunteer pro bono attorneys who speak Spanish, have experience in asylum law and can make at least a five-day commitment at the border.
